YMCA Emergency Homelessness Shelter (186 Chippewa Street in North Bay, ON)

24/7 shelter—up to 36 spaces for homeless people, including washroom and shower facilities. Broth and coffee provided by The Gathering Place.

Crisis Centre North Bay-Four Elms Emergency Shelter (1675 Cassells Street, North Bay ON)

19 bed + Emergency Overflow + Outreach Full service Emergency shelter serving men, women and children.
