Item 2:

Answer:

At this time, DNSSAB is asking proponents to outline the types of sensors their system can provide. Proponents should note in their proposal if the sensor is included or extra to their proposal and pricing.

Item 3:



What do you mean by tracking "vehicle call"?

Answer:

A vehicle call is what is considered the 'Ambulance Call Number'.

Item 4:

Please describe what kind of data, data format, and quantity of data you would like to migrate to the new system.

<u>Answer:</u> DNSSAB's expectation is that historical data from the current provider is to be imported (i.e., via excel) into the new system so that historical trends, data and reports can be used and accessed by management. The quantity of data has yet to be determined.

Item 5:

If the wifi hotspot is only for email and text messages, would you consider a smaller monthly data plan (instead of 5 GB)?

Answer:

Please note that the purpose of the hotspot connectivity is not just for texting and emails. It will be utilized to transfer data from patient monitoring devices to partner agencies/hospitals and may be utilized to access educational programs.

Item 6:

Does the wifi hotspot need to come from the telematics device itself, or would you consider an alternative solution?

Answer:

DNSSAB preference is to have a single process/solution. DNSSAB does not want to have multiple processes to ensure connectivity. The intent is to ensure the solution is not complex for the users and the service from an install, maintenance and payment perspective. If a separate modem is proposed, DNSSAB will require detailed information on the success/failure rates of the device and examples of successful implementation in a similar operation with a consideration of the geography.
