Bolduc and Bouchard awarded Governor General's Emergency Medical Service Exemplary Service Medal.

North Bay, ON: Two local paramedics with the District on Nipissing Social Services Administration Board (DNSSAB) will receive exemplary service medals at an awards gala Thursday, September 28. This year's presentations will be held in conjunction with the Ontario Association of Paramedic Chiefs (OAPC) Fall Symposium, at the Blue Mountain Resort and Conference Center.

Eric Bolduc and Tanya Bouchard are receiving the Governor General's Emergency Medical Service Exemplary Service Medal. They are among only 110 in Ontario to receive the medal this year.
