This position performs plumbing duties of the entire housing portfolio. This includes preforming day-to-day preventive maintenance duties to ensure the preservation of the housing stock. Primary functions involve; plumbing installation, repair, troubleshooting, and problem solving within the portfolio, in accordance with established standards, policies, procedures and in keeping with Building Code, TSSA, Occupational Health and Safety, Fire Code, and Residential Tenancies Act.

Qualifications:

- Secondary school diploma (Grade 12 or equivalent) required.
- Valid Certificate of Qualification Plumber 306A, in good standing with Skilled Trades Ontario, required.
- 3 years' relevant experience as a journeyperson in residential and commercial environment.
- Valid Ontario Driver's License required.
- Knowledge of Occupational Health & Safety practices; Knowledge and understanding of applicable Building Code, Plumbing Code, TSSA requirements, and Fire Code requirements;
- Knowledge of building maintenance, plumbing maintenance, and HVAC systems; Knowledge of the operation and maintenance of various tools and equipment.
- Ability to perform a broad range of plumbing maintenance repairs and installations in a residential and commercial environment.
- Proficiency in the use of tools and equipment required to perform the functions of the position.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team; Ability to respect confidentiality of tenants and staff; Ability to deal with a diverse client group with tact and diplomacy; Ability to relate to others in a tactful and professional manner.
- Ability to use computer systems for work orders; Ability to operate equipment in a safe manner; Ability to troubleshoot and problem solve.
- Interpersonal and communication skills required.
- Excellent organizational skills are required to organize and schedule daily work or tasks, while being sensitive to time constraints and resource availability. Will often be required to work toward meeting tight deadlines.
- TSSA gas trade certification (G1, G2) will be considered an asset
- WHMIS Certification and CPR/First Aid Certification an asset; Working at Heights certification an
 asset
- Knowledge of Residential Tenancies Act an asset.
- Training of Asbestos 1 & 2 an asset.
- Access to a reliable vehicle and vehicle liability insurance.
