DEADLINE EXTENDED TO NOVEMBER 24

DNSSAB Survey to Inform Future Housing Strategies Needs Resident Input

North Bay, ON: The deadline for a survey to address housing needs and challenges in the District of Nipissing has been extended. The District of Nipissing Social Services Administration Board (DNSSAB) is asking residents to answer a few short questions in a Housing Needs and Supply Study survey so that it can develop housing strategies and actions for the entire district, including 11 municipalities and two unincorporated areas. A special call-out to residents in the unincorporated areas of the District such as Redbridge, Thorne and Tilden Lake.

The information obtained through the confidential survey will help build a comprehensive picture of their community's housing experiences so that a clearer understanding of housing needs, barriers to accessing good housing, and desires for the future, all aimed at improving housing options for all residents.

“We’ve had a pretty good response to the survey but would like to see all areas of the District included in the planning – this survey will help address that and I encourage all residents to take 15 minutes to fill it out,” says DNSSAB Chair, Mark King.
