
seniors 65+: 3%





## top 3 reasons for housing loss\*

- Addiction/ substance abuse 21%
- Conflict with spouse/partner 21%
- Unsafe housing condition 17%
  - \* Based on single response

## top 3 barriers to finding housing \*\*

- Low income 57%
- Rent too high 39%
- Mental Health 20%
